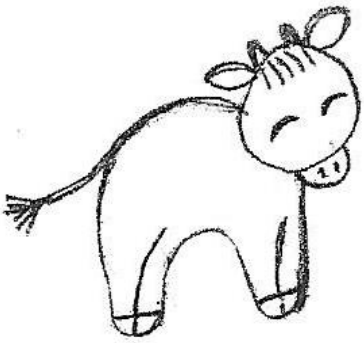
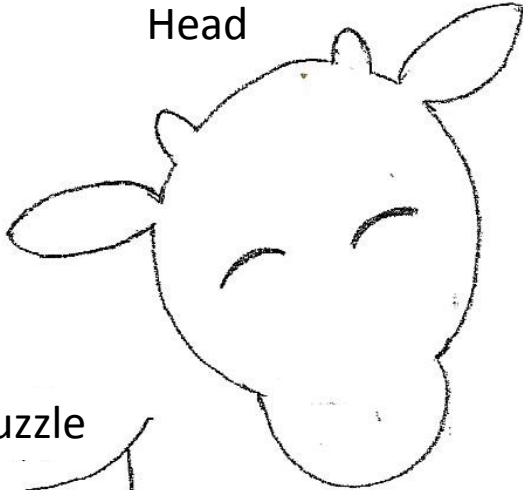


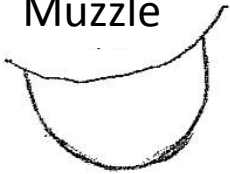
Year of the Ox Ornament



Head



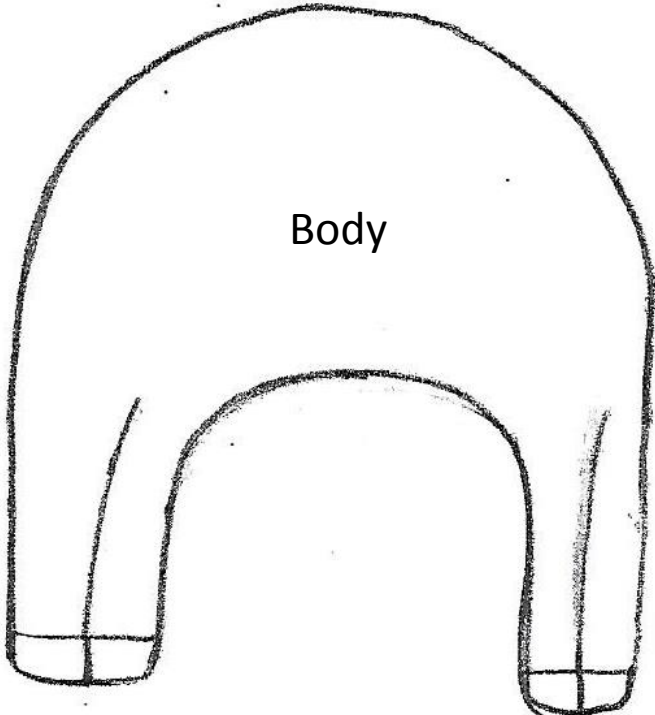
Muzzle



Horns



Body



Materials:

- Felt, (or other fabric) construction paper, or craft foam sheets.
- Yarn (for tail. And optional hair)
- Thread (for sewing felt) Or glue to attach pieces together.

Directions:

Cut out the following pieces

- 1 x Muzzle
- 2 x Head
- 2 x body
- 1 x tail (yarn)

Optional pieces

- 2 x front hooves
- 2 x back hooves
- 2 x horns
- yarn for hair

Steps:

Step 1. Gather your materials

Step 2: Cut out the pieces to make your Ox

Step 3: Attach the muzzle to the top layer for the head piece (also attach horns if you cut them out)

Step 4: Attach the two head pieces together.

Step 5: (optional) attach the hooves to the body.

Step 6: Attach the tail to either the front or back piece of the body towards the top "rear".

Step 7: Attach the two body pieces together, being careful not to accidentally glue/sew the tail into the body.

Step 8: Attach the head to the body.
